I attended the 2025 BDIAP study for molecular and approach to cut up on the 3-4th March 2025. I thoroughly enjoyed my experience. Overall it tremendously contributed towards my learning in the areas of both macroscopic cut up and molecular pathology. This programme was very well organised and included excellent talks from experienced and specialised pathologists.

The molecular study day provided deep insight and updates on various histopathology topics. I found it very useful that early morning talks were generalist focus. As a trainee this provided me with a relevant, accessible and appropriate overview. While the latter sessions were more focused but also useful and insightful. I particularly enjoyed the talk on respiratory pathology by Prof Nicholson, an area I have a specialist interest in. Case studies provided by Dr Evans were also very insightful and helped me apply my learning.
