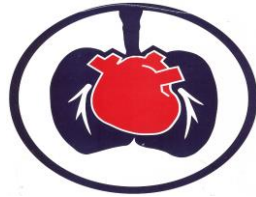


ADULT AND PAEDIATRIC CARDIOVASCULAR PATHOLOGY
